The European Commission's Farm to Fork and Biodiversity strategies that form part of the Green Deal envision a fundamental restructuring of the European and German agricultural and food sectors towards greater sustainability implying a foreseeable reduction of production volume. This has far-reaching consequences for farmers, processing companies, trade and consumers. In light of the growing world population and current crises such as the Russian war against Ukraine, a secure and sustainable food supply as well as stable and reliable value chains in the food sector are becoming increasingly important. The lack of agricultural imports is putting the systematically important security of supply in Germany, Europe and certain regions of the world under pressure. This makes it even more important to critically analyse the planned measures and where necessary, to develop alternatives. This event will therefore focus on how research and innovation can offer alternative pathways to the targets of the Farm to Fork Strategy. It will also address the possibilities to contribute to supply security and make our food systems and our agriculture more sustainable and resilient while protecting the environment, resources and the climate.

Together with high-level experts from politics, business and science, at the **"Farm to Fork Discussion: Increasing Sustainability and Securing Supply"** we want to examine the potential impact of the European Green Deal in the context of the current crises, highlight practical approaches for fostering the adaptability of the agricultural and food sectors through innovative developments and discuss how the measures of the Farm to Fork Strategy could be potentially adjusted.
